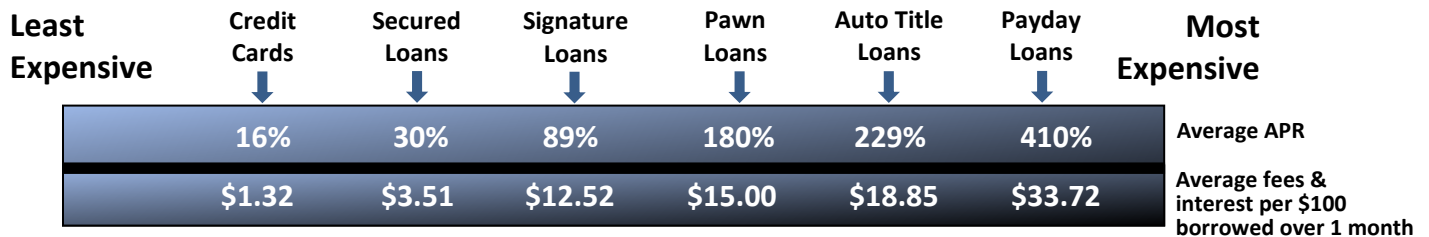

	3 will pay the loan on time as scheduled (typically 30 days)
	1 will renew 1 time before paying off the loan
	1½ will renew 2 to 4 times before paying off the loan
	4 ½ will renew 5 or more times or will never pay off the loan

- Can I afford late charges if I miss a payment?
- Do I have other credit options?
